Head Coach Terry Evans

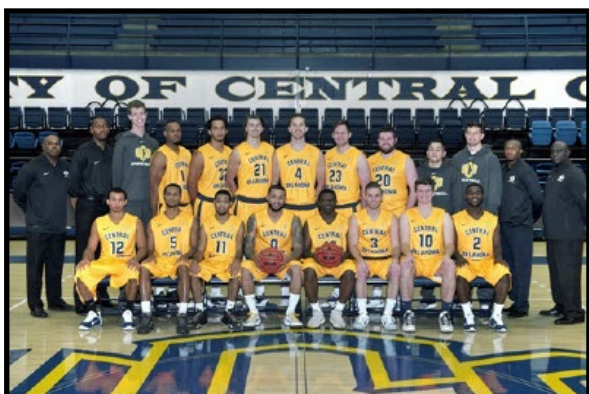

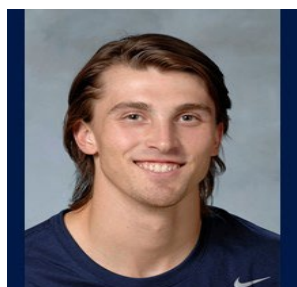
Former professional baseball player who spent four years playing minor league ball for the Houston Astros organization.

#0 Garen Wright



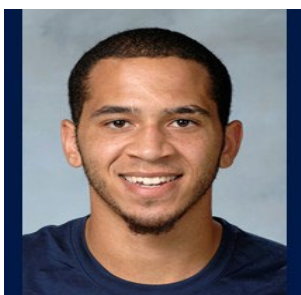
Played his first two years at a Juco and came to UCO after playing last season at division II Sioux Falls. He shot 51.2 percent from the field last season

#13 Mahlon Jones



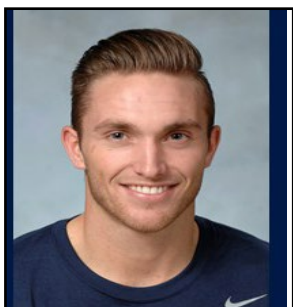
Has played in 56 games with 39 starts the past two years. Last year he shot a team-high 39.7 percent from long range.
