

#0 Garen Wright



Played his first two years at a Juco and came to UCO after playing last season at division II Sioux Falls. He shot 51.2 percent from the field last season

#13 Mahlon Jones



Has played in 56 games with 39 starts the past two years. Last year he shot a team-high 39.7 percent from long range.

#21 Cal Andrews



Came to UCO after two years at Northern Oklahoma- Enid. Last season started in 21 of 30 games, averaging 8.1 points and 5.1 rebounds

#32 Philip Brown



Junior, who is a returning starter, has played in 37 games with 32 starts the past two years.

#3 Seth Heckart

#I Trai Jordan – Played JUCO for two years at Murray State College before coming to play at UCO.

#2 Darrius Byrson – He is a senior transfer who played two years at Seminole State College and played one year at Sciences and Arts of Oklahoma.

#4 Jarred Bairstow – Came to UCO last year and was ineligible for the first 19 games and now has earned a starting position. He is from Brisbane, Australia

#10 Garrett Kilborn – Redshirt freshman from Oklahoma Christian school in Edmond, Oklahoma.

#11 Reggie Sloan – Junior newcomer who played in 59 games the past two seasons at Southwest Christian University.

#12 Jacob Richardson – Last season he averaged 4.5 points and 1.0 rebound a game while playing in 27 of 30 games.

#20 Jacob Strassle – Played in 22 games last season, averaging 3.3 points and 2.2 rebounds a game.

#23 Corbin Byford – Division I transfer, came to UCO after spending two years at Oral Roberts.

RS Taylor Hicks – From Edmond Memorial High Schoo, averaged 12.3 points, three assists and two steals a game.

RS Jace Kerr – Two time All- Conference selection at Forgan High School. Helped lead the Bulldogs to three state championships
